Instructions for making the "Opel Memory" game

- Print out these two pages.

 Use these to make the box for your 'Opel Memory' game.
- Then cut out the yellow "Opel Memory" cover page.

 This is for sticking onto the finished box later on.
- You'll find the template for the "Opel Memory" folding box on the next page. Cut it out and use it as a stencil on thick black paper. Following the template, fold over the areas to be glued, fold the box and glue the sides together.
- Please print the second "Opel Memory" cards sheet on both sides,

 ideally on thinner paper, as these are the actual cards to use in the game.
- Now all you have to do is to cut out the paired cards showing the Mokka-e, the Green Monster and so on and then you can get on with the game.



"Opel Memory" – here's how it works

For 2-6 players, aged 4 years and up

t the start of the game, all the cards are placed on the table, face down. In our "Opel Memory" game, 24 Opel pairs are hiding under the 48 cards. The aim is to find as many pairs as possible. The youngest player begins and turns over two cards. If they both show identical pictures, then you have found a pair! Put them both in front of you, face up. If not, it's the next player's turn. The cards that have been turned over must not change position during a game. That means you have to remember exactly where each Opel model is in order to win the game.
